Tariff Amendment - Low Intervention Metering

TransGas Limited (TransGas) last updated the tariffs related to Measurement Canada requirements for Low Intervention Meters in 2005. Subsequent to that change, Measurement Canada undertook to review the business practices of pipelines in the natural gas industry to better understand their operation and the relationship between the pipelines and its various customer types.

In June of 2009, a new bulletin was issued by Measurement Canada which reflected their better understanding of the natural gas pipeline business relationships with its customers. This bulletin provided new guidelines with respect to measurement that are to be incorporated into natural gas pipeline company tariffs.

Amendments to the tariffs were made to be in compliance with Measurement Canada requirements. Failure to obtain low intervention meter status would have required a significant increase in operating costs, as a third party measurement company would have to be contracted to provide measurement services for those meters.

The amendments to the TransGas tariff were reviewed and supported by the Customer Dialogue group. The amendments are consistent with the requirements of the Measurement Canada bulletin.
